## Auditory Activity No. 28 Transcript

OOOOOOO.....!!! Yummy!!!! This looks like a recipe for making pikelets!!!! Do you like eating pikelets? Yes, so do !!!! Let's find out how to make them!!!

You will need your writing pencil, a blue pencil and a green pencil today. You will need your writing pencil first. Let's see...What do we need to make pikelets? Aaaahh! There's a list.... It says.... "What you need". Can you see it too?

We need 1 cup of self raising flour

1/4 cup of caster sugar

a pinch of bi-carb soda

1 egg

and 3/4 cup milk

Now, let's find out how to make them. It says "What to do".

"when see bubbles flip you the pikelets". What was that???? Did you see that??? That didn't make sense, did it?

Oh, I see. This is a puzzle to work out. Some of these instructions have the words all mixed up. You have to put the words in the right order so that they make sense. By the way, how can we flip the pikelet when we haven't even started to make any yet????

Let me help you work it all out. Ready?????

I will read the words and you tell me how they should be. You work out which line I am reading and put the correct number in the box beside it. That way we will know which instruction to do first, and so on. After we have done that, you can go back and write the words for each one in the correct order.

Then you will know how to make some yummy pikelets!!

Ready???

Listen carefully. Look especially for the first two words that you hear me say to try to find which line I am reading.

No. 1 *Mix flour and sugar together.* Put no.1 in the box beside those words. *Mix flour and sugar together.*

No. 2 *Add bi-carb soda.* Put no.2 in the box beside those words. *Add bi-carb soda.*

No. 3 *Add the milk to the dry mix.* Put no.3 in the box beside those words. *Add the milk to the dry mix.*

No. 4 *Lastly add the beaten egg.* Put no.4 in the box beside those words. *Lastly add the beaten egg.*

No. 5 *Cook small amounts of mix.* Put no.5 in the box beside those words. *Cook small amounts of mix.*

No. 6 *Flip the pikelets when you see bubbles.* Put no.6 in the box beside those words. *Flip the pikelets when you see bubbles.*

No. 7 *Lift out of the pan when brown.* Put no.7 in the box beside those words. *Lift out of the pan when brown.*

Well done!

Now, before you fix the sentences that are jumbled up, let's do the bit at the bottom.

Here are three sentences, but they are not finished.

I will tell you a phrase (or a group of words), then you must decide which sentence it belongs to. Then write that phrase on the line to finish that sentence.

Are you ready? This is the first one.

..... out of his cage The grouchy man slept out of his cage.

Did our mouse escape out of his cage?

Who gave the pretty flowers out of his cage?

Which is the sentence that makes sense? Write the words ..... out of his cage on the correct line.

Here is the next one.

..... to the bride Which one makes sense? Write the words ..... to the bride on the correct line.

If you have done those two correctly, this one should make sense in the sentence that is left.

..... on the couch Write the words ..... on the couch on the line to finish the last sentence.

Use your blue pencil now, and put a circle around the sentence that is *not* a question.

Put a blue circle around the sentence that is *not* asking a question.

Next, you need a green pencil. In those 3 sentences, I can find 2 adjectives.

Put a green cross on those 2 adjectives. (Remember, adjectives are describing words.)

Now you must go back to the recipe and fix it up.

Listen while I read what to do so that you can write the sentences with the words in the right order.

Firstly, put a tick next to the sentences that have the words in the wrong order. Then with your writing pencil write each sentence with the words in the correct order on the line underneath.

No. 1 *Mix flour and sugar together.*

No. 2 *Add bi-carb soda.*

No. 3 *Add the milk to the dry mix.*

No. 4 *Lastly add the beaten egg.*

No. 5 *Cook small amounts of mix.*

No. 6 *Flip the pikelets when you see bubbles.*

No. 7 *Lift out of the pan when brown.*

When you have done that, put your pencil down as you have finished your work for today.
