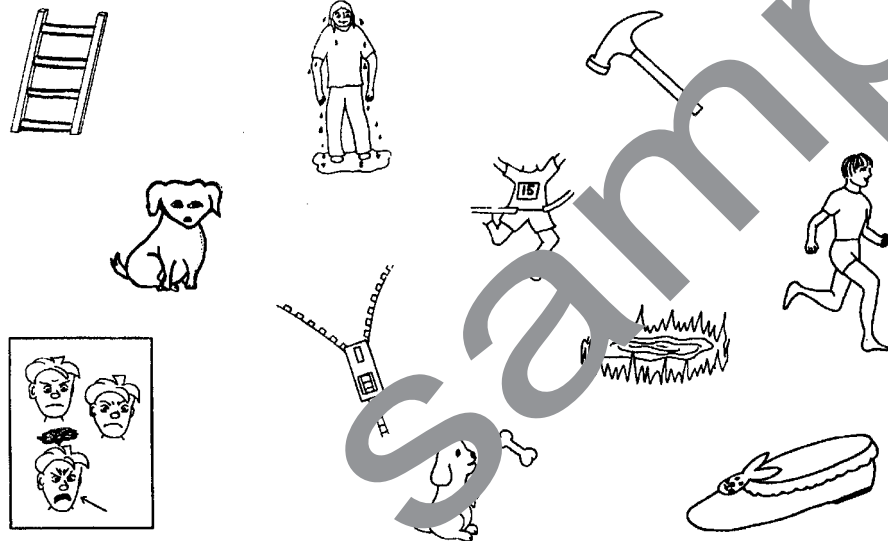
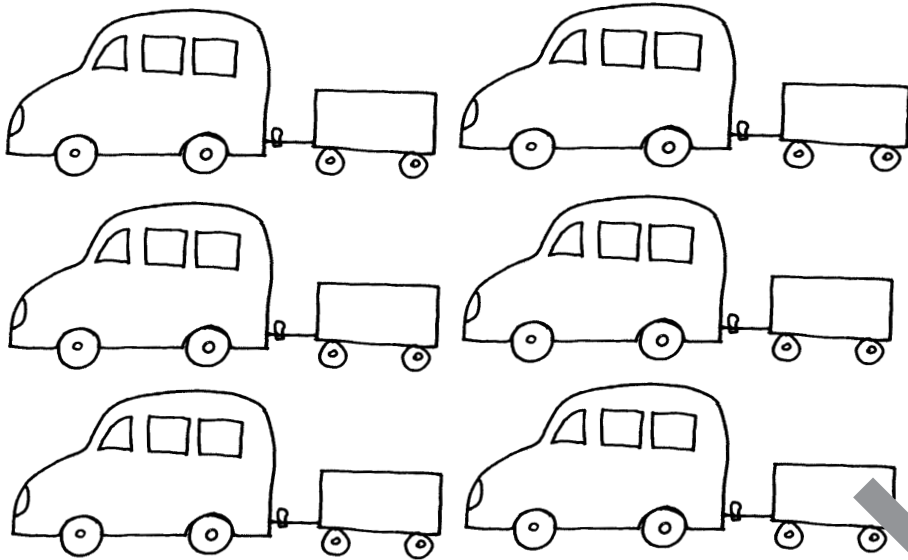

Auditory Activity No. 6 Transcript

Today you will need a red pencil and a blue pencil. Firstly, use your blue pencil.

Have you written your name on the line at the top of the page.

Today we are talking about base words with endings again.

You will need to remember the new part of the rule about 2 letters after a short vowel before an ending.

Listen as I say these words. Write the base word on the car. Then decide if you need to double the last letter before the ending. If you do, write the extra letter above the towbar. Then write the ending on the trailer.

Listen very carefully as I say the first one for you. flapping Write the base word flap in the space on the car. Write the letter above the towbar if you need to double the last letter. If you do, write the letter above the towbar. Now write the ending ing on the trailer. Now do the same thing for each of these words.

slotted Not line. grubby slimmer Not line. hobble crossest

Next, Listen as I say the words for these pictures that are below the dark line.

Put a blue circle around each one with the ending ing Remember, as I say the words for the pictures, circle each one that has an ing ending, with your blue pencil.

ladder dripping hammer puppy winning zipper muddy running crossest begging slipper

Now put a cross on the ones with an er ending. Put a cross on the ones with an er ending. I will say the words for the pictures again for you.

You should have put 4 crosses.

There are 3 pictures left. Write the word for each one underneath its picture, still using your blue pencil. I'll say that again for you. Write the word for each picture that is left under that picture, still using your blue pencil

Look at these pictures again. Some of them are the names of things, some of them are things that we can do, some of them are describing words.

Use your red pencil, and put a triangle around all the pictures that are names of things. Put a red triangle around each picture that is the name of something. If you find them all, you will have 5 red triangles.
