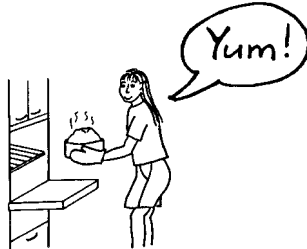

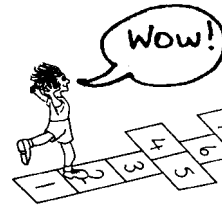
Mum is cooking a cake.
