## Auditory Activity No. 6 Transcript

Today you will need a red pencil, a blue pencil and a green pencil. Use your green pencil first. Look at the top of the page. Can you see where it says "My name is..." with a line beside it? With your green pencil write your name on that line.

Look at the pictures on your page. Point to each one, as I say the word for each picture.
